Dr. Hamden (Erika) and the team she led spent 10 years building FIREBall, a telescope designed to hang from a giant balloon 130,000 feet in the stratosphere and observe clouds of hydrogen gas. Unfortunately, the balloon had a hole in it and after decade of hard work, the telescope crashed along with the hopes and the confidence of Erika and her team. This 2 g ED fellow, astrophysicist, and galactic explorer now instructs others how to turn failure into fuel to move onward and upward. Over its history, NCR evolved into a software-and services-led enterprise technology provider, a leading provider to the banking, retail, and hospitality sectors. Julie Untener also had her beginnings in Dayton, then joined NCR in 1986, and took on ITS roles of increasing responsibility including global assignments. Listen as we explore the leadership challenges she faced, including working through a personal battle with breast cancer, and continues to face as NCR transforms in the 21st century.

August 18 Virtual: "Exciting the Next Generation to Solve Real World Problems," featuring Nancy Conrad, Founding Chairman, The Conrad Foundation, Author, Speaker, Entrepreneur, and Educator

Nancy has become a recognized leader in transformative education and named one of the top 100 leaders in STEM education, serving as a featured speaker at national and international conferences. Nancy has testified before the U.S. House of Representatives Committee on Science, Space and Technology detailing how the Conrad Foundation exemplifies the use of partnership to improve STEM education. She is the wife of the late astronaut Pete Conrad, who during the Apollo 12 mission became the third man to walk on the moon. Along with her husband Pete, she founded (4) companies to make space travel more accessible and following his tragic death, she pursued initiatives to assist small and rural hospital emergency services and advocate for patient safety. Multi-faceted and energetic, she has used her public platform to make the world a better place through engaging youth across the globe to use STEM, innovation and entrepreneurship to create commercially viable products that solve real world problems.
